ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Master's degree from the institutions accredited by the Ministry of Education, Thailand
2. GPA of at least 3.25
3. Take the AU-English Proficiency Test and the interview. The application who submitted the TOEFL (Ibt) 90 or (PBT) 575 or IELTS 6.5 or those with the Bachelor's or Master's Degree from USA, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand are exempted from the AU English Proficiency Test
4. GMAT / GRE scores or pass the exam of the school.
5. Two acceptable letters of recommendation
6. A research proposal
7. Statement of Purpose indicating why the applicant wants to pursue a doctoral degree

(In case an applicant has not passed GMAT or TOEFL, he/she needs to take internal exams before the interview takes place)

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. A completed application form
2. Official Transcript of the previous university attended (3 copies)
3. Bachelor's and Master's Degree Certificate (3 copies)
4. Citizen identification card and Residence registration (3 copies) – For Thai Applicants
5. Passport (3 copies) – For Non-Thai Applicants
6. Eight (1x1 inch size) photographs (formal attire, not in graduation gown)
7. Resume (3 copies)
8. Statement of Purpose

Note: All documents must be endorsed with signature and submitted in person within the last day of application period, otherwise the application will not be considered and he/she will not be allowed to appear for the Admission interview.
